

WEBINAR: SCHOOL LEAD DRINKING WATER REPORTS

The New York State Education Department and the New York State Department of Health are hosting an informational webinar on the use of the NYSDOH data entry system in HERDS (Health Electronic Response Data System) within the NYS Health Commerce System (HCS) for required reporting of lead testing in school drinking water.
