Each session will train Grade K-5 science teachers on the use of “Mystery Science” NGGS-aligned hands-on units. The same material is presented on both days so attendees may attend either session.

“Mystery Science” is an online science curriculum which offers fully developed lessons using video instruction and hands-on science opportunities at all K-5 grade levels. Each “Mystery” begins with a question that is explored through engaging videos and stimulating discussion questions. Through video-guided hands-on investigations, students solve the mystery.
