

This letter is our official application to NYSED for a charter for The Staten Island Green Charter School for Environmental Discovery. In accordance with NYSED guidelines, we are providing required information about the proposed school.

**c. Applicant Founding Group:** Our group began focusing on the need for education reform and developed the concept for a concerned citizens green research and discovery model based upon the history of Staten Island’s toxic landfill. Dr. Reiss began recruiting STEM Educators for this project within NYC schools, families of children on Staten Island, and green business organizations such as Staten Island Economic Development Corporation (SIEDC), S.I. Zoo, S.I. Museum, Blue Heron Conservation, NYS Department of Environmental Conservation, NYC Parks Department, and Pratt recycling, who is presently working with the Net Zero School, which shares a similar vision and will partner with us. We also have partnered with the Youth Committee of Community Planning Board 1 to repair the damaged recreation center, Cromwell, which needs restoration and is a cornerstone for the underserved population in our community. The application is authored by Dr. Carole Reiss, and Dr. Elizabeth Tavares of Columbia Teacher’s College. Dr. Tavares is Special Education Bilingual teacher at the NYC DOE.

We also are working with the Curriculum Foundation and Success for All Foundation. Our ELA program and our dual language and lower grade curriculum will assist English language learners (ELL) and students with disabilities (SWD). We provide small group assistance and technology for all learners.

Dr. Carole B. Reiss, Ph.D., is the proposed Executive Director—K–12 Leadership at Capella University; completed the Emerging Leaders New Leaders program at the NYC Department of Education; Former Director of Health and Fitness in Region 10, NYC DOE 2014-2007. Joining her in writing the ELL and Special Needs section is Dr. Elizabeth Tavares of Columbia Teachers College, and Dr. Vincent Maligno of the NYC DOE.(Retired).

We also have a Parent Liaison from the Children’s Aid Society, Ms. Madeline Vasquez, and an ELL teacher, Mr. Scott Fried as well as Business Partners, Debi Hansen, Victory State Bank, and David D’Alberio who is leading our Board of Directors and is a Financial Planner and Advisor.

**f. Application History:** SIGCSED applied to SUNY Charter Institute in 2010, 2011, 2012, and 2013. We applied to NYSED in October 2013 Round 2 and Round 1 in February 2015. We are reapplying for Round 2, June 28, 2016. All applications were withdrawn in order to allow members to expand community outreach, and target our ELL and Special Populations community, as well as reflect on areas that were not considered sufficient by NYSED.

## II. Proposed Charter Information

**a. Proposed Name:** The Staten Island Green Charter School for Environmental Discovery

**b. Proposed Location:** We intend to be located on the North Shore of Staten Island within the Rosebank area. We have spoken to the District 31 Superintendent regarding DOE building space, and we have also negotiated space on Bay Street in the Rosebank/Clifton area at St. Mary’s Catholic School Our second choice is Immaculate Concepcion in St. George. Our relator is De Falco Realty. We have looked at several north Shore locations but the parents prefer St. Mary’s in Rosebank as well as Immaculate Concepcion in St. George.

**c. Planned Grades and Enrollment:** SIGCSED is a K–5 school with 25 students per class.

**d. Proposed Management and/or Partnering Organization:** No Proposed Management. We partner with the Staten Island Mental Health Society, Sylvan Learning, Neighborhood Housing Services (HUD), and Jewish Family Services.

**e. Proposed School Mission:** The Staten Island Green Charter School for Environmental Discovery will deliver outstanding inclusive and diverse educational instruction for students who are English Language Learners and all students from Special Populations and diverse backgrounds so they can acquire the knowledge, skills and strength of character necessary to successfully meet future academic, career, social and environmental challenges in the 21st century. All learners are provided academic and cultural support so that they can thrive in a diverse, multicultural society where values and good citizenship are a part of successful student learning.

**f. School Overview:** The Staten Island Green Charter School for Environmental Discovery (SIGCSED) will be built on the following cornerstones:

- **Achievement for All Students**—We believe all children have the capacity to succeed and will do so when they have the opportunity to learn from and interact with competent, dedicated, and motivated teachers. Our educators are committed to providing each student with the learning opportunities and guidance critical for academic achievement and character development by using data from multiple assessments to guide instruction and assess progress.
- **Significance of K–5 Success (Growth)**—Future academic and occupational success is contingent on successful mastery of elementary school subjects. Students who fail to establish a strong foundation of knowledge and skills in the elementary grades are likely to fall further behind as they move on to middle school, high school and beyond. We intend to inform our instructional practices by assessing students’ needs at the point of entry and continuing to assess their progress over time using multiple means of instructional Common Core aligned assessments as well as project based student centered learning. We offer a cooperative learning model to ensure creative instruction in ELA, math, science, engineering, technology, art, music and wellness.
- **Pedagogical Model (Constructivism)**—SIGCSED’s founding team bases its educational model on John Dewey’s Constructivist learning theory and Jean Piaget’s stages of cognitive development. Our experience in education supports the idea that hands-on and experience-based learning, coupled with direct instructional support, is the most effective way of teaching young students. The curriculum our planning team developed, using the Environmentally Integrated Concept of Learning, is embedded in the psychological and educational research of Jean Piaget. Learning is a dynamic activity; acquiring knowledge is not just memorizing facts. For students to be successful, teachers must actively engage them as partners in the learning process. Motivation is a key element of learning for students and teachers. Hands on experiments and activities are useful learning tools—especially for diverse students; however, real learning requires more direct one-to-one instruction. Learning takes time and is not instantaneous. For significant learning to occur, ideas need to be revisited, discussed, evaluated and applied to project-based learning assignments.
- **School Success from the Start**—SIGCSED’s initial classes will begin in Kindergarten, allowing our students to grow with our program to achieve full success using the academic model of our school. Students will be assessed during the early part of the Kindergarten program to identify areas of strength and need for intervention in special services. This is included in our full proposal. We also offer a dual language program for our ELL students which will give all students a chance to learn another language and experience other cultures as a part of our cooperative learning model.
- **School Leader**—Ms. Joan Stewart a resident of The Bank Street Emerging Leaders Program who has demonstrated success in areas essential for developing and maintaining an outstanding educational program for underserved students. She specializes in teaching students to take ownership of their learning through Guided Discovery.
- **STEM Education**—SIGCSED will use the STEM education program, specifically designed to prepare students to develop the knowledge and skills essential for academic and occupational success for the economically and environmentally challenging circumstances of the 21<sup>st</sup> century. Local concerns for our environment as well as robotics

which we imported from a teacher who developed a successful model in Hawaii and he embedded Hands on Learning in our aligned curriculum with NYS Common Core Standards. Parents from two other Staten Island charter schools praised our initiatives and would like to see our programs partnered in their home schools.

- **Media and Technology**—SIGCSED teachers will incorporate advanced computer hardware and software applications to expand and enhance learning opportunities. Technology will support all instructional tasks modeled by the teacher using Guided Discovery and Hands-on-Learning.

**g. Target Population/Community Served:** Our target population is Immigrant and English Language Learners and Special Needs Learners who reside on the North Shore of Staten Island where the need for alternative safe school settings are in high demand. This is evidenced in our feedback through our community outreach in the neighborhoods of the North Shore.

### **III. Enrollment and retention of students with disabilities, English language learners, and students who are eligible applicants for the free and reduced price lunch program.**

**a. Admissions preference**— SIGCSED will target students who meet federal/state guidelines for low socio-economic families and/or who are eligible for federal meal programs on the North Shore of Staten Island. At least 83% of students will qualify for free or reduced lunch. We will conduct outreach to organizations such as Families Helping Families, The Community Education Council, and Family Support Services, as well as mental health and wellness organizations such as HASC, JBFCS-Staten Island, Children’s Aid Society, Pre-K for All, and NYCDOE. Our team is dedicated to improving quality education for our poorest children. Dr. Reiss has begun reaching out to day care centers, head starts, pre-K programs, Children’s Aid Society, Staten Island Mental Health, Jewish Families Services, and the Jewish Community Pre-K programs. We also have included in our application a Public Outreach Table that displays all of our public meetings, flyers, pictures, and parent signatures as well as our breakdown of the demographics of SIGCSED. Our public outreach is ongoing and we intend for to reach all communities in District 31. We have met with Education Director Rose Kerr from the Borough President’s Office who has furnished us with the information pertaining to ELL students on the North Shore who will be making up 50% of the population at our school. We also are accounting for our Liberian, Indian, Arabic, Turkish, Russian, and Spanish speaking populations. We expect our school to be well diversified and have reached out to Andrea Lella at Families Helping Families to address the needs of special education students applying to our school.

We intend to review data and analyze students in need of intervention, by working with groups like Parent To Parent for SWD, and attend parent social meetings, parent workshops, and community parent engagement meetings with the Community Education Council. The Child Find Survey will be used to seek out SWD. Schools are currently working with us to supply us with names of special needs students interested in coming to our school.

The parents would like our school to open as soon as possible and have begun speaking at Community Planning Board meetings as evidenced in the *Staten Island Advance* article on February 18, 2016 and at our February 16, 2016 meeting and at our recent Youth Committee Community Planning Meeting on June 10, 2016, and at the District Community Planning Board Meeting on June 14, 2016 at All Saints Episcopal Church in Westerleigh. The need for partnerships to find students who will need language, emotional-social, and academic support is the main focus for our school and this is part of our agreement with the community stakeholders, such as the Community Education Council and parents from local schools who have responded to our surveys. We gathered the parent’s requests and created a database located at Quick

Schools INC, Constant Contact, and Facebook to analyze the needs of our community. Ninety-five percent of our parents were interested in having their children learn environmental education. One hundred percent of our parents want their children to go to a school that is environmentally healthy and safe. We also advertise on our website to attract all learners with specific learning needs for our program as we have budgeted for services that we anticipate they will be needing based on community feedback.

**b. High retention rates for all SIGCSED students**—At SIGCSED using data driven instruction (DDI) that incorporates hands-on, individual, and small group experiential learning aligned with Common Core and NY State Common Core Learning Standards will help us retain our ELL students. The DDI method uses assessments, such as The Brigance Early Childhood Developmental Inventory, to screen for K–1 readiness, and for ELL students, the NYSITELL will be used for entrance and the NYSESLAT for ongoing assessment. Students in grades 2–5 will be assessed using MWEA-Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) and a variety of assessments, including Achieve 3000. OP-ED Assessments will be used in fall, winter and spring to measure baseline assessments for each student and to guide intervention and discussion around the instructional methods needed to support student progress. Home Language Inventory will be used as a pre-assessment for all incoming students. Students will be given small group, one-to-one tutoring and parent and teacher partnerships to ensure that high quality teaching methods result in higher student learning and retention at our school. Every child is important to us and we are committed to making sure that we use the data to inform instruction, as well as working hard to communicate with children through conferencing and helping them to establish and meet their goals. SIGCSED’s approach to core learning subjects will be based on successful learning models including: 5E (engage, explore, explain, elaborate and evaluate) Learning Cycle Model, (Barman, 1989; Ramsey, 1993); the EIC model (using the environment as an integrated context for improving student performance SIC/SEER model). Parents will receive support for effective “at home” assistance with homework and projects via our website, and teacher conferences, aligned to weekly progress reports.

**c. Methodology to effectively serve (and retain) ELL students**—Students whose home language is not English will be assessed to identify those who will require additional support. As per the NYSED procedures, all ELL students will be identified through a process that includes home language questionnaires, informal interviews with students in English and their native language, and LAB-R. All teachers will be trained to not only identify students who have a deficiency in English but also how to effectively communicate with both student and parent. English language learners will be provided classroom support through individual and small peer group opportunities. ELL students requiring more intensive interventions will receive services via a pullout program and/or intervention with a paraprofessional or associate teacher using tablets where necessary for guided instruction and assessment. Ongoing student English language literacy and proficiency progress will be conducted to determine if continued special services are warranted. All ELL students will be given the NYSESLAT examination annually to assess student progress. Technology will be used for each student’s own language. Tasks and instructions will be recorded for all learners speaking languages other than English. Students will learn subjects in their home language in addition to English and Spanish.

**d. Methodology to effectively serve (and retain) special education students**—Students with disabilities will be provided service in the least restrictive environment in accordance with Federal and State regulations including section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1972 and Education Law 2853(4) and applicable federal laws and regulations in accordance with

Individual Education Plans (IEP) recommended by the CSE of the students' school district of residence. All students with existing IEPs will be admitted and provided with appropriate services according to their IEP, and our abilities to accommodate them. We plan to develop a special-education team that includes speech teachers, a school psychologist, a physical therapist, occupational therapist, and when needed, will use outside agencies. SIGCSED will use an extensive three-tiered RTI (Response to Intervention) process to ensure that the needs of all students who are struggling will be identified quickly, thereby avoiding the need for more intensive levels of intervention wherever possible. SIGCSED will coordinate students' evaluations and services with teachers, Student Achievement Coordinator, ELL coordinator and Parent(s). SIGCSED will provide training and support for all general education teachers to ensure they are knowledgeable about the needs of students with disabilities by providing the student's IEP to all teachers. Behavior modifications programs will be aligned to students needs using the support offered to us from The Staten Island Mental Health Society. We will work closely with Advocacy for Parents to make certain that student's needs are being met.

#### **IV. Public Outreach and Community Support**

The founders of SIGCSED have reached out to and have met with local political leaders and community organizations, in addition to extensive outreach to parents. We have obtained 500 signatures from the community in support of our school through Pre-K and Kindergarten fairs, recycling projects, beach cleanups, health walks at Clove Lake Park, presentations at the Staten Island Children's Museum, Barnes and Noble, Panera Bread, Starbucks, and Perkins Restaurant.

Throughout the month of February, we took part in several public outreach and community events. For example, we spoke to the District 31 Superintendent at the CEC Meeting on February 1, 2016 and were included on the March 7, 2016 agenda. We attended the Community School Board 1 Youth Committee meeting, of which Dr. Carole Reiss is a member at the New Brighton Reform Church in St. George, Staten Island, on February 2, 2016. There we received a lot of feedback from the members who are a part of the North Shore initiative to rebuild Cromwell, a 75 year old community center which has been destroyed by Superstorm Sandy. Dr. Reiss is also a member of the Let's Rebuild Cromwell Committee. Kathy Vidal, Youth Committee member of Community Board 1, expressed the need for self-contained special education classes, sports and wellness programs, and tutoring in reading and math. We spoke to parents at the Rosebank Community Planning Board 1 Meeting on February 16, 2017, and were asked if we could open our school with a K-5 program to bring in the students from a nearby closing Staten Island Community Charter School (SICCS). We were featured in a *Staten Island Advance* article about the closing of SICCS on February 18, 2016. Another charter school on Staten Island had advertised to parents that they will serve students with special needs, but parents are complaining that this is not entirely true. We have proven to all parents of students with special needs that we will align instruction for their child and provide all services on their IEP and give extra support where needed. We have reassured all of our parents that our program is unlike any other charter school and we will focus on the needs for success for every student in our school.

The community is excited about our environmental education programs which has now become part of the New Generation Scope and Sequence for the NYC Department of Education. We also gathered signatures at Perkins from concerned community members as well as students who are age appropriate for our school, and students with disabilities and ELL students who would like to attend our school. On February 25, we attended the PRE-K School Fair at P.S. 20,

in Port Richmond Staten Island which is one of our catchment areas and one that Rose Kerr (Borough President's Office) has helped us target.

Through our public Outreach to Families Helping Families CEO, Andrea Lella, we were praised and applauded for our initiatives and fortitude to develop an environmental school where students become actively engaged in problem-solving and becoming community activists with strong ties to the borough and the City and State of New York. We also met with parents groups from P.S. 13 in Rosebank who are requesting that our school also become a middle school to further service students with special needs.
