I am writing to notify you that the Board of Regents, at its regularly scheduled meeting on July 19, 2010, approved the following revisions to the initial charter of the Brownsville Ascend Charter School:

- In the 2009-2010 school year, add two sections of first grade, increasing the enrollment by 50 students from 124 students to 174 students;
- Increase enrollment in 2010-2011 in grades K through 2 from 210 to 249 students; and
- Increase enrollment in 2011-2012 in grades K through 3 from 250 to 398 students.
